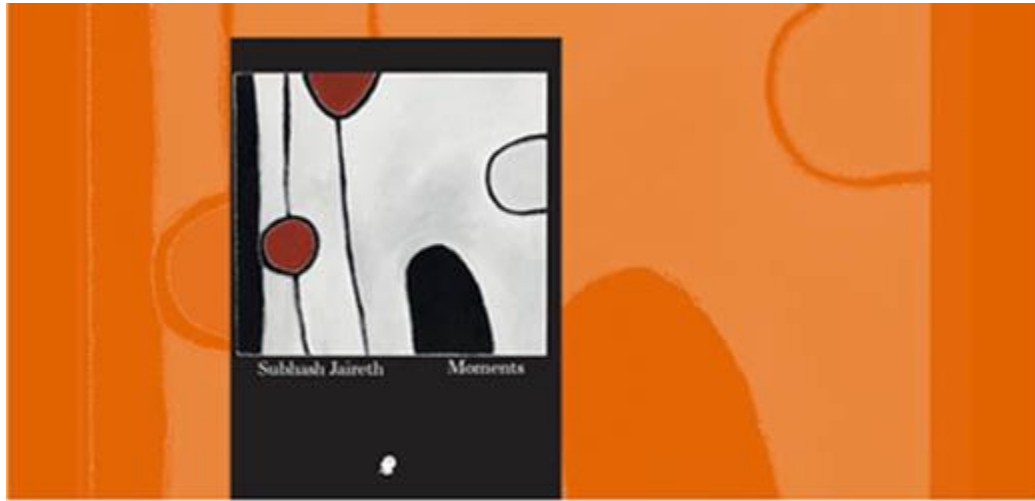


# Book Launch
